# KEDARNATH

**Kedarnath, nestled near the Chorabari Glacier, the source of Mandakini River, stands amidst frosty Himalayan peaks. Situated 14 kilometers from Gaurikund, the nearest roadhead, it rests at 11,755 feet. Mythologically, the temple is linked to a revered stone hump, tracing back to the Mahabharata epic. Pandavas sought forgiveness from Lord Shiva here but were denied, leading Shiva to leave his hump. The site also hosts a temple dedicated to Adi Shankaracharya. Kedarnath is part of the Char Dham pilgrimage, essential to any package you choose.**





# BADRINATH

**The Badrinath Temple, dedicated to Lord Vishnu, rests at the base of the stunning Nilkantha mountain. Established by Guru Adi Shankaracharya in the eighth century, it's among the most accessible Char Dham temples. After decades, it underwent renovations. Hot springs nearby, reaching 40 degrees Celsius, serve as laundry spots. Adi Shankaracharya discovered the idol of Badrinayaran in the Alakananda River, leading to the temple's construction. Constructed in the 16th century by the King of Garhwal, the temple boasts intricate carvings resembling a Buddhist Vihara. Legend has it that this site was where Lord Shiva meditated under a Badri tree shaded by Goddess Lakshmi, giving the place its name.**

- Please note that this trip is incredibly budget-friendly, catering to those seeking economical visits to Kedarnath and Badrinath with basic accommodations.

## *Short Itinerary*

- **Day-1** Start Drive from Delhi to Base.
- **Day-2** Base to Sonprayag and start trek towards “Kedarnath”.
- **Day-3** Trek Down from Kedarnath to Sonprayag and Start to stay.
- **Day-4** Start to Badrinath and head back to the stay after visit.
- **Day-5** After Breakfast Start to Rishikesh for Rafting and Ganga Aarti in the evening. Overnight stay in Rishikesh.
- **Day-6** Start Drive from Rishikesh to Delhi for Drop.





## Day-1

- Pick up from Delhi Aero City Metro Station at 6am.
- Beginning our journey at **6 am**, we'll set off with our companions, anticipating a scenic drive to the base.
- Along the way, we'll be treated to the breathtaking sight of Devprayag Sangam, where the holy rivers Bhagirathi and Alaknanda merge into the sacred Ganga.
- Later, we'll witness Rudraprayag, another significant confluence of the Alaknanda and Mandakini rivers.
- After a day of travel, we'll reach our stay for the night, indulge in a well-deserved dinner, and prepare for the challenging trek to Kedarnath tomorrow.

**NOTE:** Costs associated with reaching the boarding point are personal expenses and are not included in the event fee.





## Day-2

- At 2 AM, we'll have a wake-up call for a quick refresh. Today is darshan day at Kedarnath.
- Beginning at 4 AM, we head to Gaurikund. Jeep rides may experience delays, particularly during peak times, lasting 2 to 3 hours. Participants opting for mule or dole rides need to arrange on their own.
- Arrive at Gaurikund by 5 or 6 AM, where a 16km hike to Kedarnath Temple awaits. We anticipate reaching the temple in the late afternoon for darshan.
- After Darshan reach stay and have dinner.

**Note:** The accommodation will be basic, providing comfortable beds for sleeping and common toilet tents. However, there will be no bathing facilities available.





## *Day-3*

- We'll start our day with the beautiful scenery and the sunlight casting a golden hue on the Himalayan peaks.
- After Breakfast we will start descending to Gaurikund.
- By Late afternoon we will reach Sonprayag and start towards Badrinath Base.
- Reach Stay by Night.
- Enjoy dinner and relax for the remainder of the day, feeling the satisfying tiredness from the lengthy and scenic trek.

**NOTE:** The accommodation will be in a simple hotel, with rooms shared by 3 or 4 guests, offering clean washrooms and cozy beds for a comfortable sleep.





## Day-4

- Get an early start in the morning and head towards Badrinath Temple.
- Reach temple and proceed to Darshan.
- We may expect huge crowd and darshan may take more than 2-3hrs.
- Spend Some time and proceed to India's Last Village, "Mana" Village.
- One can visit these places by walk like Vyas Gufa, Ganesh Gufa, Bheempul and the "Mukh (Origin)" of the Saraswati River.
- If time permits we will cover Vasudhara Falls which will be 5kms trek (One Side). The Decision will be taken by the Trek Lead.
- Head back to the stay and dinner followed by.

**NOTE:** The accommodation will be in a simple hotel, with rooms shared by 3 or 4 guests, offering clean washrooms and cozy beds for a comfortable sleep.





## Day-5

- Get an early start in the morning and head towards Rishikesh.
- Today its going to bit adventurous day.
- Reaching Rafting point. (**Rafting cost is not included in the package**).
- If you want to try on something adventurous and exciting, then you must not miss out on this white-water river rafting experience in Rishikesh.
- Complete Rafting and proceed to Triveni Ghat for Ganga Aarti. It is also called the Maha Aarti.
- Spend some time and head back to the stay. Enroute Dinner.

**Note:** Entry fees and rafting expenses in Rishikesh are your responsibility. Please note this visit is complimentary, and Rishikesh can be crowded. Ensure you return to the vehicle on time as instructed by Trek Lead.





## *Day-6*

- Checkout from Hotel and Start to Delhi.
- Reach Delhi by 12pm.
- Book your return journey after 3:00PM. As we may get delayed by weather conditions, traffic or landslides.
- As our journey together comes to an end.
- Though our paths may diverge now, the bond we've formed will remain cherished.
- Here's wishing you safe travels and may our paths cross again in the future.
