

## **KEDARNATH**

Kedarnath, nestled near the Chorabari Glacier, the source of Mandakini River, stands amidst frosty Himalayan peaks. Situated 14 kilometers from Gaurikund, the nearest roadhead, it rests at 11,755 feet. Mythologically, the temple is linked to a revered stone hump, tracing back to the Mahabharata epic. Pandavas sought forgiveness from Lord Shiva here but were denied, leading Shiva to leave his hump. The site also hosts a temple dedicated to Adi Shankaracharya. Kedarnath is part of the Char Dham pilgrimage, essential to any package you choose.



## **TUNGNATH**

Tungnath Temple, nestled in Uttarakhand's Rudraprayag district, is a revered Hindu shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva. It holds the distinction of being one of the highest Shiva temples globally and the tallest among the Panch Kedar temples. Perched at 3,680 meters (12,073 feet), it's set amidst the picturesque Tungnath mountain range, overlooking the Mandakini and Alaknanda valleys. With strong ties to the Pandavas from the Mahabharata, the temple attracts devotees and trekkers alike, offering spiritual solace and stunning Himalayan views. Additionally, it serves as the starting point for the trek to Chandrashila Peak, known for its breathtaking panoramas.



## **CHANDRASHILA**

Chandrashila Peak is a prominent summit located in the Uttarakhand region of India. Situated at an elevation of approximately 4,000 meters (13,000 feet), it offers breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding Himalayan peaks, including Nanda Devi, Trishul, Chaukhamba, and Kedar Peak. The peak holds significant spiritual significance, particularly due to its association with the Tungnath Temple, which is considered one of the highest Shiva shrines globally. Many trekkers visit Chandrashila as it serves as the culmination point of the popular Tungnath-Chandrashila trek, known for its stunning vistas and relatively moderate difficulty level.



#### **IMPORTANT NOTE**

- Please note that this trip is incredibly budgetfriendly, catering to those seeking economical visits to Kedarnath with basic accommodations.
- If you expect luxury within this price range, it's unrealistic. BNW is transparent about our offerings and limitations, and we do not tolerate drama if darshan is affected by natural disasters or if authorities close darshan.
- Please Read Itinerary & Includes Excludes Carefully.



- Day-1 Start Drive from Delhi to Base.
- **Day-2** Base to Sonprayag and start trek towards "Kedarnath".
- **Day-3** Trek Down from Kedarnath to Sonprayag and Start to stay.
- Day-4 Begin at the starting point of the Tungnath trek, visit the Tungnath temple and Chandrashila peak, then head to Rishikesh for the Ganga Aarti and an overnight stay.
- **Day-5** Start to Rafting point in the morning. Complete rafting and start to delhi.



- Pick up from Delhi Aero City Metro Station at 6am.
- Beginning our journey at **6 am**, we'll set off with our companions, anticipating a scenic drive to the base.
- Along the way, we'll be treated to the breathtaking sight of Devprayag Sangam, where the holy rivers Bhagirathi and Alaknanda merge into the sacred Ganga.
- Later, we'll witness Rudraprayag, another significant confluence of the Alaknanda and Mandakini rivers.
- After a day of travel, we'll reach our stay for the night, indulge in a well-deserved dinner, and prepare for the challenging trek to Kedarnath tomorrow.

**NOTE:** Costs associated with reaching the boarding point are personal expenses and are not included in the event fee.



- At 2 AM, we'll have a wake-up call for a quick refresh. Today is darshan day at Kedarnath.
- Beginning at 4 AM, we head to Gaurikund. Jeep rides may experience delays, particularly during peak times, lasting 2 to 3 hours. Participants opting for mule or dole rides need to arrange on their own.
- Arrive at Gaurikund by 5 or 6 AM, where a 16km hike to Kedarnath Temple awaits. We anticipate reaching the temple in the late afternoon for darshan.
- After Darshan reach stay and have dinner.

**Note:** The accommodation will be basic, providing comfortable beds for sleeping and common toilet tents. However, there will be no bathing facilities available.



- We'll start our day with the beautiful scenery and the sunlight casting a golden hue on the Himalayan peaks.
- After Breakfast we will start descending to Gaurikund.
- By Late afternoon we will reach Sonprayag and start towards Tungnath Base.
- Reach Stay by Night.
- Enjoy dinner and relax for the remainder of the day, feeling the satisfying tiredness from the lengthy and scenic trek.

**NOTE:** The accommodation will be in a simple hotel, with rooms shared by 3 or 4 guests, offering clean washrooms and cozy beds for a comfortable sleep.



- Get an early start in the morning and head towards Tungnath Trek start point.
- Start your trek for 4 km to Tungnath Mandir which is one of the highest Shiva temples in the world and is the highest of the five Panch Kedar temples.
- After temple visit start to Chandrashila peak were we have to trek 1km to reach the peak.
- Chandrashila literally means "Moon Rock". It is located at a height of about 3,690 metres above sea level.
- Complete trek by 11am and start to Rishikesh.
- Proceed to Triveni Ghat for Ganga Aarti. It is also called the Maha Aarti.
- Spend some time and head back to the stay. Enroute Dinner.

**NOTE:** The accommodation will be in a simple hotel, with rooms shared by 3 or 4 guests, offering clean washrooms and cozy beds for a comfortable sleep.



- Get an early start in the morning and head towards Rishikesh Rafting point.
- Today its going to bit adventurous day.
- Reach Rafting point. (Rafting cost is not included in the package).
- If you want to try on something adventurous and exciting, then you must not miss out on this whitewater river rafting experience in Rishikesh.
- Complete Rafting and proceed to Delhi.
- Reach Delhi by 7pm.
- Book your return journey after 9:00PM. As we may get delayed by weather conditions, traffic or landslides.

**Note:** Entry fees and rafting expenses in Rishikesh are your responsibility. Please note this visit is complimentary, and Rishikesh can be crowded. Ensure you return to the vehicle on time as instructed by Trek Lead.
